WEST WIRRAL OPEN 2010 COMPETITION INFORMATION

- 1. The competition will be played by Stroke Play over 18 holes.
- 2. The winner and West Wirral Open Golf Champion will be the competitor who returns the lowest net score.
- 3. Prizes will be offered for at least 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th lowest nett scores returned, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest gross scores returned. Additional prizes will be awarded for longest drives (Handicaps Scr 9 & 10 28), nearest the pin (4 par three's). No competitor may receive more than one major prize.
- 4. The championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and such Local Rules as shall be approved by the Competition Committee.
- 5. The Competition Committee, whose decision shall be final, shall settle all disputes.
- 6. All competitors shall be of Amateur Status, male over 18 years old, and be current members of an Affiliated Golf Club and be in possession of a current Active playing handicap certified by the Club Secretary.
- 7. The Competition Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason for their action.
- 8. Entry fees will not be returned unless notification of scratching is received by the committee one week before the event.
- 9. Handicap certificates MUST be produced on the day to verify handicaps, with the exception of members of the Hoylake, West Hoyle and Irby Golf Clubs whose handicaps will be checked locally.
- 10. Secretaries of clubs will be notified of starting times.
- 11. Prize presentation will take place at approximately 8.30 p.m. in the clubhouse, and prizewinners must be in attendance or forfeit their prize.
- 12. Competitors must report to the recorder no later than 15 minutes before their allocated tee time and be on the tee at least 5 minutes before their tee time. An automatic two-stroke penalty will be imposed to any who are late on the tee.
- 13. Golf Buggies are allowed to be used for this competition
